Psychiatric care and mental health services

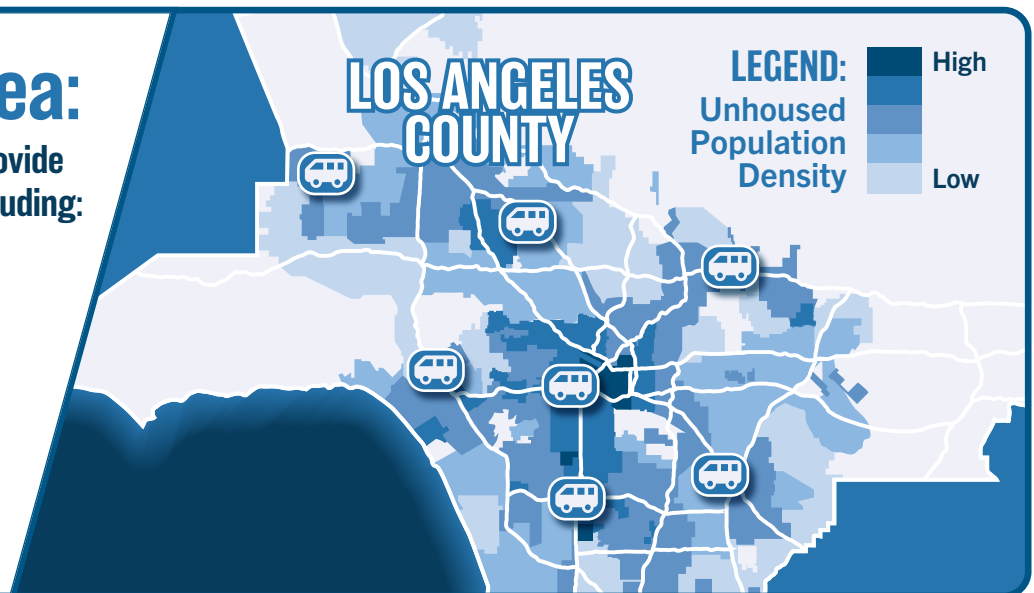


Referrals to housing and social services
